## Other ways to help per Jeriene Grimes, President, Cobb NAACP:

- Feed a community of disenfranchised families- go beyond the outreach of MUST a lot of folks didn't get the memo of free food - senior facilities, trailer parks, extended stays, subsidized housing units, minority communities
- 2. Hire or influence someone with hiring authority to take a chance on someone not typically given a chance of employment be intentional
- 3. Become a mentor to an underserved youth in the community
- 4. Be willing to risk your position and speak out against racism
- 5. Create a culture that is supportive and welcoming in your world of influence (personal & professional)
- 6. Don't apologize for how God created us we are all masterpieces our differences are what make us so special
- 7. Have courageous content conversations with white people about race
- 8. Invite black America to the table.....

A few nuggets of thought to share for race reconciliation:

- Teach love regardless of color, class or culture
- Acknowledge affirm act
- Listening: learn to be comfortable with being uncomfortable
- Awareness & recognition white ain't always right
- Playing field is not level
- Take risk & relationship it's okay to hurt & be hurt
- Caring about people means caring about the situations they are in
